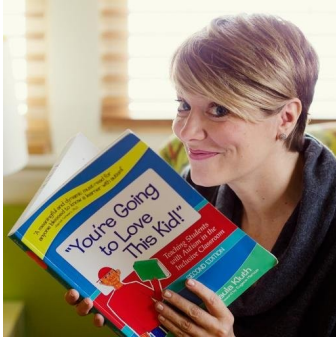


Dr. Paula Kluth

- Creating more active and responsive lessons/interactions
- Making the classroom, home and supportive environment more comfortable
- Providing opportunities for communication and social skill development
- Using fascinations and special interests as a support tool

The session will focus on the importance of pushing beyond access and participation and asking schools and other environments to challenge individuals and to understand each person as complex and capable.
