Executive Functioning is an umbrella term for the mental processes that serve a supervisory role in thinking or behavior. Individuals with autism spectrum disorders, attention disorders and learning disabilities have trouble with planning, have weak ability to monitor their own behavior and performance and struggle with situations where they must shift flexibly from one thought or behavior to another. We can help these young people by creating plans that include both short term support for daily success and long term strategies that facilitate the development of executive skills and build greater independence over time.



- This workshop will provide parents, teachers and other professionals with an understanding of executive functioning
- and how to help children who have weak executive skills.

First we will focus on what research tells us about executive functioning. We will use that information to consider practical principles of intervention, and then we will apply these to intervention planning and to creating an "EF Smart" environment. Participants will have the opportunity to consider the needs of an individual child and to create an intervention plan over the course of the day. There will be ample time for questions and discussion.
