Sabrina Ung, M.A., is a clinical psychology extern at Florissa working under the supervision of our clinical psychologists to provide assessment and therapy services. Sabrina graduated from the University of California, Irvine, with a bachelor's degree in psychology and social behavior, and a bachelor's degree in education sciences. She is currently in her fifth year in the clinical psychology Ph.D. program at Northern Illinois University with an emphasis in developmental psychopathology, which includes knowledge of how emotional and behavioral problems develop in children and across the lifespan. Sabrina's research explores parents' influences on infants' emotion regulation development.

Throughout her graduate training, Sabrina has worked in a university clinic with individuals and families, providing psychological assessments and therapy for a variety of presenting concerns (e.g., anxiety disorders, panic disorder, depression, trauma, learning difficulties, and attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder). Sabrina also has conducted assessments and provided therapy for children, families, and adults with emotional, social, and behavioral difficulties, and developmental disorders at a private practice Konick & Associates. She has also conducted exposure therapy in clinic and community settings through Advanced Therapeutic Solutions for Anxiety's Adventure Camps and Winter Adventure Camps, which are intensive outpatient therapy programs for children with selective mutism. Sabrina has co-facilitated various group therapies, including social skills groups, and anxiety and depression groups.

Sabrina utilizes evidence-based treatments to inform her work with clients, both for psychological assessments and therapy. Her approach is grounded in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy in the context of family systems.
