She is currently in her fifth year of Northern Illinois University's (NIU) clinical psychology Ph.D. program where she is pursuing an emphasis in developmental psychopathology and trauma psychology. Her current research focuses on how the family unit can promote resilient child outcomes in families experiencing adversity.

Joanna has provided evidence-based treatments and conducted psychological assessments at NIU's Psychological Services Center for individuals with various presenting problems (e.g., anxiety disorders, depressive disorders, attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder, trauma, learning disorders, language disorders). She has provided evidence-based interventions for children with selective mutism through Advanced Therapeutic Solutions' Adventure Camp, Winter Adventure, Courage Club, and peer sessions. Through this intensive therapy program, Joanna provided exposures in both the clinical and community settings. Joanna has additionally assisted with teen anxiety and depression groups and provided comprehensive psychological assessments to children and adolescents for a variety of concerns (e.g., attention, executive functioning, learning difficulties, social difficulties, emotional and behavioral concerns) at a private practice in Naperville, Susan Myket, Ph.D. & Associates.
