THE MAIN GOAL OF FLORISSA IS TO PROVIDE local evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of children (ages birth to 22). Florissa staff provide a multi-disciplinary evidence-based approach to evaluation and treatment for children with developmental, medical, emotional, learning, social, and behavior difficulties. We seek to help families promote the healthiest outcomes for their children. The ongoing supports and resources available at Florissa are vital to improving the system of care for children in our local communities.

OUR VISION A Collaborative Community Where Children and Families Flourish

- **EARLY INTERVENTION** is a program of therapies for children birth to 3 years of age who have developmental delays. The sooner they start, the further they will go!
- SCREENINGS through the Early Intervention Program utilize autism specific and general developmental measures completed by caregivers to screen for the presence of social, emotional, behavioral, and other developmental concerns.
- **CONSULTATIONS** with caregivers are available to help them better understand their child's strengths and difficulties, current diagnoses, and ways to develop their child's skills.

- **COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATIONS** include best practices for testing for a full range of emotional and behavioral concerns, academic and learning problems, trauma, and inattention. We also provide an multi-disciplinary evaluation for more complex developmental concerns such as autism and FASDs. The assessment team may include a child psychologist, pediatrician, speech/language pathologist, and occupational therapist.
- **Fraction of the Rapy** addresses early developmental skills, emotion regulation, communication and social skills. Visit florissacenter.org or contact our office for updates on available groups.
- DIRECT THERAPIES for children over the age of 3 include evidence-based interventions for specific concerns.

- **COMMUNITY TRAINING** is offered by our experienced staff and experts in the field across a range of topics to community members, educators, professionals, caregivers and more. Visit our website for a list of sample topics.
- SUPPORT for families and caregivers is provided through ongoing family events and sibling events.
- **RESOURCE ROOM** contains books, suggested online resources, learning aids, and visual supports. These resources are available to families, educators, service providers, and anyone else with an interest in strategies to promote child development. Florissa staff can also help with the creation of personalized schedules and visual aids.
